Albert Charles Noland of San Simon died in Tucson on November 9, 2017 at the age of 87. He was born in Douglas, Arizona on March 27, 1930 to Albert Franklin Noland, Sr. and Artie Era (Ray) Noland. Albert was a lifelong Rancher, served in the United States Army during the Korean War, was a member of the American Legion, Arizona Cattle Growers Assoc, honorary member of the Arizona County Attorney's and Sheriff Assoc, and the AQHA.
