Andy enjoyed shooting pool and loved the challenge he faced with the friends he met all those nights at TJ's Bar.

He sure appreciated everyone who showed up to see him at this benefits. He

was blown away. Though the words were hard to come to his lips by this time—if you listened and thought about those words—you would get what he meant. The day after his benefit at the VFW, while on his way to his final radiation escapade, he said, “It rained and it rained and I got so wet, it blew me away.” It was his way of saying “my cup runneth over.” He was happy. Mickie is receiving so many loving thoughts from friends and family around the world—that’s a measure of a good good man.

We are all left with his unconditional love and these words from Andy’s lips, “Don’t waste a second. And tell the people you love, that you love them.”

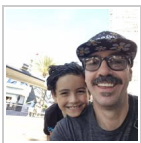
