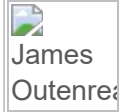

Her last two weeks were very difficullt for her. She finally agreed to go to the hospital on April 17th. We sat on the bed discussing things before we called for an ambulance. One of the last things she said to me was "I do not think I am coming home. We called for the ambulance, as we did not have the equipment to keep her oxygen level up for a trip to Tucson. A few days later I looked at her watch she wanted me to bring her, and it had stoped three minutes before we called for the ambulance. That was almost the same time she told me shey would not return home. Asdeep as my grief is for loving the love of my life, I must realize how much. Better off she is with God, pain free. I hurt so much and will always miss her, but I have to get my act together somehow. I want To thank all of those who knew her for Their words of support. god bless you al.*

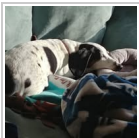
