Arlene Forsyth passed away on February 15, 2023, from sudden complications of long-term illness. She was born on March 19, 1944, in Topeka, Kansas. Arlene worked at several local businesses in Willcox, including Gordon's Market, a flower shop, and finally at the Willcox Elementary School as an Aide for 13 years.

She adored her granddaughters, Riley and Hailey Forsyth. They were her pride and joy, and they would play and learn sewing and cooking skills. She found strength in them and made every effort to ensure she expressed her love and care for them.

She will be sorely missed by all that knew her. Her kindness, laughter, and genuine love of all brought many happy moments and long-lasting joy. Her strength through her illness is a testament to her will to keep providing for others, and the commitments she had made to so many.

Arlene was preceded in death by her brother Jimmy, and her sister Alberta.
