Born to Arthur D. & Marie G. Stinson in Phoenix, AZ, 4/1/1927, passed away, Saturday, March 4th (2017). The family had a dairy and farmed at 67th Ave & the Salt River in Phoenix. He was the 3rd child with 2 older sisters and 3 younger sisters. He attended grade school at Fowler Elementary and went to Phoenix Union High School. He joined the Navy on his 18th birthday and served 2 hitches from 12 May 1945 until 24 July 1946 and 11 December 1947 until 10 December 1951. He was trained to be an aircraft mechanic. Married to Donna Segó in 1953 and had two children, Susan Marie in 1954; and Wayne Arthur in 1955. From 1956 till 1970 he was as an aircraft mechanic at Luke Air Force Base in Phoenix. . He then transferred to the Phoenix Indian Hospital as Maintenance Foreman until his retirement in 1980, at which time they moved to Sunizona where they now live.

He enjoyed hunting, fishing and flying.
