Beloved mother, sister, grandmother, great grandmother, and great great grandmother Barbara Jean Malaska Yeager passed away at the age of 87 on March 26, 2024, at Brookdale Tanque Verde Senior Living in Tucson, Arizona. She loved the people and spent lots of time there.
