



Bernard "Bud" Hone Brunner

April 3, 1933 - November 7, 2024

Bernard "Bud" Hone Brunner of Elfrida passed away at his daughter's home in Lordsburg, New Mexico on Thursday evening November 7, 2024, at the age of 91. He was born in Bull Hill, Christian County, Missouri on April 3, 1933, to Bernard Francis Brunner and Maurine (Hone) Brunner. Bud served in the United States Army serving in Fulda, Germany during the Korean War, he worked for the United States Forest Service and retired as the District Forest Ranger in the Coronado National Forest District in Douglas. Bud also was a Pecan Farmer, a member of the Farm Bureau Association and the Arizona Pecan Farmers. He was a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Preceding him in death was his wife of fifty-seven years Velia Torres Brunner who passed away on May 8, 2014, and his sister Anne Heidsick.
