She continued her love affair with the Chiricahua Mountains and frequently hiked and birded there with friends. Betty spent hours and hours cataloging the wild flowers and edible plants in the Chiricahuas. Betty was a member of the Audubon Society, the local historical society, Cochise Historical Society and volunteered for Wings over Willcox. Betty will be greatly missed by her friends and family.
