Bruce C. Norris of Willcox passed away on July 1, 2020 at Canyon Vista Medical Center in Sierra Vista at the age of 73. He was born in Richmond, Virginia on July 31, 1946 to Paul Norris and Alice Hill Norris. Bruce was an accountant for SSVEC and retired in August of 2011. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Willcox, where he was the soundman and was known as Mr. Music Man, he was an active volunteer for the Willcox Food Pantry. 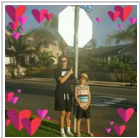
