Carl M. Klug, of Pearce died June 7, 2014 at the age of 89. He was born in Bethel, Connecticut on July 4, 1924 to Joseph Klug and May (nee Siegert) Klug. Carl served in the US Army during WW II, attended West Point and was a M.I.T. Graduate. He was a retire Aerospace Engineer working for Lockheed, NASA and the Defense Project; Carl worked on the U-2 and the Hubble Space Telescope. He was involved with the Strategic Defense Initiative. Carl was a volunteer for the Amerind Foundation, a board member of the Sunsites/Pearce Library; help organized the Sunsites Community Center, loved to Square Dance and was a member of the Sunsites Bridge Club. On July 25, 1953 in Cape Cod, Massachusetts he married Jane Perine who survives him. He is also survived by his sons Carl Michael (Karen) Klug, Jr. of Carson City, Nevada and Peter J.
