August 5, 1958 - March 24, 2021

Diana Lynn Hicks passed away at home in Willcox on March 24, 2021 at the age of 62. She was born August 5, 1958 in Tempe, Arizona to Owen Clifford Donham and Charlotte Mae Armstrong. Diana went to Safford schools, dropping out her senior year but returned the following year and graduated from Pima High School. Literally three days later on May 21, 1977, she married Jerry Michael Hicks "Mike" from Hampton, South Carolina. They welcomed their first child that November on the 17th, Owen Michael. On February 16, 1981 they welcomed their second child Misty Renee.
