He was a member of the Old Time Fiddlers , was a Master Fiddler and was inducted into the Old Time Fiddler Hall of Fame. Don was a expert craftsman and made numerous fiddles. He had been a member of the Willcox Sheriff Posse. On March 4, 1948 in Avondale, Arizona he married Oleta Buchan who survives him. Also surviving are his children Rick (Beverly) Eskue of Vail, Arizona, Susan (Rick) Crabtree of Sellersburg, Indiana and Dan (Jennifer) Eskue of Soldotna, Alaska, 8 grandchildren and 15 great grandchildren. 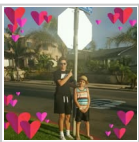
