



Dora "Dorita" F. de Peralta

September 9, 1930 - June 4, 2017

Dora "Dorita" F. de Peralta formerly of Willcox died June 4, 2017 in Phoenix at the age of 86. She was born in Agua Prieta, Sonora, Mexico on September 9, 1930 to Teodoro Figueroa and Ramona Maria Abril. Dora and her husband Everardo immigrated to the United States in 1958 and eventually moved and settle in the Kansas Settlement area. They loved Willcox and the Kansas Settlement communities. She was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church, sang in the church choir and was a reader at the church. Dora was been known for her homemade tamales and tortillas and her eggs and raw milk and fresh cheese. She loved animals, especially her dogs. She and her husband Everardo had a great appreciation for Northern Cochise Community Hospital. Survivors include her children: College professor and administrator, Dr. Everett F. Peralta, of Phoenix; U.S. Army Sgt., ret. Dora F. Peralta of Willcox; Processing Superintendent Frank J. (Margaret) Peralta of Deming, New Mexico and Social Security Administrator, ret. Fernando (Rosie) Peralta of Martinez, California, along with 4 grandchildren. Also surviving are her sisters Ramona Renteria of Bisbee and Maria Jesus (Mago) Medina of Cumpas, Sonora, Mexico. Preceding her in death was her husband Everardo Grijava Peralta. A Rosary will be offered 7:00 P.M. on Thursday, June 8, 2017 at Westlawn Chapel. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated 10:00 A.M. on Friday, June 9, 2017 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church. Burial will follow in Sunset Cemetery. 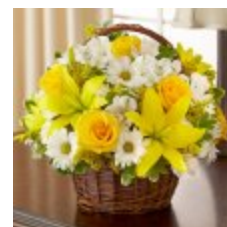

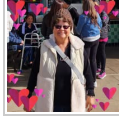
