E. Pierre Brehm, (SGM RET, US Army) of Willcox passed away at home early Tuesday morning, August 13, 2024, at the age of 94. He was born in St. Mary's, Pennsylvania on August 17, 1929, to Edward Thomas Brehm and Petronilla (Leuschel) Brehm. Pierre was a retired Sergeant Major in the United States Army and had served in the Korean War. He also was a retired Postmaster, in 1986 he moved to Arizona and was involved in many community affairs to include friends of the library bookstore in Willcox, Chiricahua Museum, was a volunteer for the Willcox Chamber of Commerce and was the official tour guide for the Chamber of Commerce, he also volunteered at the Rex Allen Day Museum, in 1996 he was awarded Willcox Citizen of the Year. Pierre was a life member of the Arizona Rangers and had the rank of Captain. In 2000 he was awarded Arizona Ranger of the Year. He also taught save driving for AARP. Pierre had been attending Wynne Chapel in Cochise. A Funeral Service will be held at 1:00 pm on Wednesday, August 21, 2024, at Wynne Chapel with viewing starting at noon. Military burial will follow in Cochise Cemetery.
