Edward A. Trappman of Elfrida died July 9, 2015 in Huachuca City at the age of 97. He was born in Willcox on March 5, 1918 to Ernest Trappman and Nancy Delinda Ingraham Trappman. Ed was a lifelong resident of Arizona, was a land excavator working for numerous ranchers and farmers in the Sulphur Springs Valley, he served in the US Navy during WW II. He was a member of the American Legion in Douglas, the Elks Lodge in Douglas and enjoyed hunting. On December 10, 1938 in Lordsburg, New Mexico he married Jessie Kelly who preceded him in death on August 5, 2012.
