



## Eunice Horton

September 3, 1929 - March 8, 2015

Eunice H. Horton died March 8, 2015 at the age of 85. She was born in Genoa, Nev. to Robert and Lena (Nielsen) Hawkins on Sep. 3, 1929.

She was a longtime office worker and plied her skills in various offices around the world, including Reno- Sparks, Nev.; Honolulu, Hawaii; Agana, Guam; Los Angeles, Calif.; Sierra Vista, Ariz.; Camp Zama, Japan; Pittsburgh, Penn. and Zwiebrucken, Germany.

She has resided in Sunsites, Ariz. since her retirement in 1990. She is survived by her husband Gary Horton of Sunsites, Ariz. and a sister Carol Hendrix of Gilbert, Ariz., two grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. Her only child, Robert L. Flury, preceded her in death in 2009.

A private cremation was handled by the Westlawn Chapel Mortuary and Crematory of Willcox, Ariz. Her cremains will be interred at the Mountain View Cemetery, Masonic Mausoleum in Reno, Nev.

A Memorial Service for Eunice will be held at the VFW Post at 114 Ford Road in Sunsites at 2 p.m. on Friday March 20.
