When I was little my mom would go to the little store and get us a candy bar or whatever sweet we were craving. I would always eat mine slowly and about half way through Wedo would be done with his. I would feel sorry for him and act like I was full and didn't want the rest of mine so he would eat it. You know thats love if a kid gives up candy, the funny part is I'm 34 now and I still did it...lol.

Nobody could ever fill the void that will be in my heart and life now that he is gone. Im so thankful that my children are old enough to

remember the time they had with their Tata. He means so much to them and they had so many good times together. He loved them and you could see it in his smile whenever they were around. I hope I can raise them with the values and the morals that he and my mom taught me. Over the last couple days I have heard from people how proud he was of me and how much he loved me. I have always known that in my heart, but its nice to know that he shared that with others. It gives me a feeling of peace and content knowing that I made him happy. That I helped to make his time here on this earth enjoyable. I hope he knows that he did the same for me. He was a good man and had a heart of gold. Every little girl should be so lucky to have a man like this as their dad/stepdad. I never called Wedo dad I always called him "Wed" that doesn't mean I didn't think of him as a dad, that was just my name for him. And no matter how old I got he always said I was his little girl...

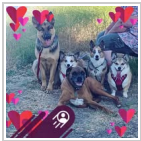

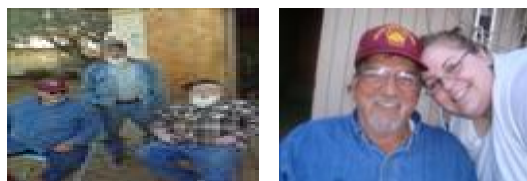

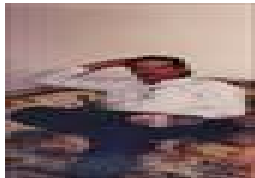
