August 9, 1932 - August 10, 2023

Glenn Smith of Sunizona passed away at his home, Thursday morning, August 10, 2023, at the age of 91. He was born in Waxahachie, Texas on August 9, 1932, to Eugene Smith and Ethel (Hale) Smith. Glenn served in the United States Army and moved to Arizona in 1966 where he was a lifelong farmer. He was a very active member of the First Baptist Church of Sunizona. On June 6, 1975, at the First Baptist Church of Sunizona he married his wife Evelyn who survives him. 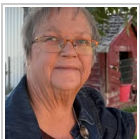

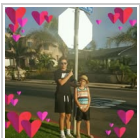
