

Glenn St.Clair

December 5, 1927 - November 24, 2018

Glenn Daniel St.Clair passed away early, November 24, 2018, in Willcox, Arizona after suffering a stroke, shy of his 91st birthday. Glenn was born in Spring Creek, Texas, December 5, 1927, to Mark & Millie (McMillin) St.Clair. After a brief stint as a rodeo cowboy he married Dorothy Lee Kinnaird in Bonham, Texas. They came to the Willcox area in 1953 from Texas via Washington state. Glenn began farming in the Stewart District and Cochise area. Glenn lived and farmed in the Sunizona area during the late 1960's and 1970's. There, he grew sorghum, wheat, oats and cotton. He was also very well known in the local area for his watermelons. Although purchased prior to the early 1980's, Glenn purchased a farm in Cochise and moved onto the farm, where he currently resided. Also, anyone who knew Glenn knew he was an avid hunter and fisherman. Glenn is survived by his wife of 70+ years Dorothy; children Ron (Gail) St. Clair of Cochise, Danny (Bonnie) St.Clair of Pearce and Kim Powell (Rick) of Boca Raton, Florida. Glenn also has four grandchildren; Diane (Brian) Allen of Sunsites, Rachel (Alex) Serrano of Cary, North Carolina, Kevin (Kate) St.Clair of Elfrida and Jared (Meredith) St. Clair of Evergreen, Colorado. He is also survived by five great grandchildren; Brianna and TJ Allen, Karlie and Owen St. Clair and Vivian St. Clair. Preceding him in death was his daughter Glenda "Babe" Caroline St. Clair. 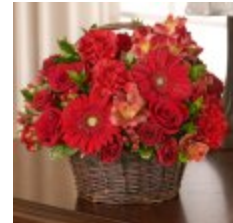
