October 29, 1921 - November 25, 2016

Gus Arzberger of Willcox died at his home in the Kansas Settlement on November 25, 2016 at the age of 95. He was born at the Arzberger homestead in the Kansas Settlement on October 29, 1921 to Frederick William Arzberger and Gertrude Bertha Cartwright Arzberger. Gus was a lifelong resident of Willcox, served in the US Army during WWII receiving a bronze star. He farmed, ranched and had his private pilot license. He served 4 years in the Arizona House of Representatives and 12 years in the Arizona State Senate. Gus was a charter member of the Willcox Elks Lodge#2131, was in the Civil Air Patrol for 30 years, a member of the VFW and the Sheriff Posse. On August 17, 1974 in Safford he married Marsha Daniels who survives him. Also surviving are his children Gus (Sharon) Arzberger, Jr and K.Ellen (John) Wilson, step daughter Cristy Ann (Eric) Hunt and step son Daniel Combs. His grandchildren Brandon (Tracey) Wilson and J.J. Brown, great grandchildren Samatha and Balee Brown and step grandchildren Evan Hunt, Cameron Hunt and Gibson Hunt also survive him. Preceding him in death was his first wife Jackie , 1 brother and 4 sisters. Memorial Services will be 10:00 AM on Friday, December 9, 2016 at the Willcox Elks Lodge with a flag presentation by the Fort Huachuca Military Honor Guard. A luncheon will follow the memorial.
