Harold Gene Frizzell, a PRCA Gold Card member, passed away in his sleep July 22, 2020 at the age of 82. Frizzell was born in Sandborn, Iowa; later moving to South Dakota and eventually Arizona. Frizzell competed in the calf roping, team roping, and steer wrestling, rodeoing all over the United States. He is survived by his son, Jeff Frizzell, two granddaughters, Caitlin Reynolds and McKenzie Frizzell, and great-grandchildren, Owen and Stormi Reynolds. Frizzell was well known for his real estate business, and his involvement with the movie industry. Both him and his son, Jeff, worked as wranglers and stuntmen in westerns filmed in Arizona. Frizzell worked nearly 15 years on the White Stallion Ranch as a head wrangler; later running his real estate business during the 1980s and 1990s. He was well known for his dedication to his work, and the rope horses he and his son competed on.

According to his son, Jeff, “you could always find Dad at a horse sale or auction.” It was his favorite thing to do, and what kept the family in excellent horses over the years. The family believes there is not a horse sale or large auction in the western United States that he did not attend. Frizzell passed on his love for rodeo and horses to his son and two granddaughters, who compete in the roping events.

Frizzell played a vital role in the rodeo careers of his family. With his son and

granddaughter, McKenzie, currently competing on one of the last horses he bought as a three year old colt. His love for the western way of life will live on through his family, and the work ethic he instilled in each member. At Frizzell's request a small funeral service will be held August 1, 2020 at 10 a.m. in Dragoon, Ariz. at the Russellville-Dragoon cemetery.
