



Harrison "Harry" Boyd Owens

February 21, 1947 - December 18, 2023

Harrison (Harry) Boyd Owens, age 76, of Tucson, AZ, went home to be with the Lord on Monday, December 18, 2023. He was born in Deming, NM, on February 21, 1947.

Harry was a loving husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather and loved spending time with his family and sharing the good news and gospel of salvation with everyone he could. As an infant, his family moved to Willcox, AZ, where Harry was raised and attended grade school and high school.

Harry married his wife Donna in 1968, with whom he would raise 5 children, and after studying Real Estate law at the University of Arizona, he decided to move back to his hometown of Willcox in 1972 to work with his father, Virgil Owens, at the Willcox Pump Company. Soon thereafter, Harry and friend Joe Thatcher started an automobile wrecker and repair business called T & O Enterprises. Harry would eventually buy out his business partner and become sole owner of T&O Enterprises, a business he ran for 42 years. In 1985, Harry started and ran Willcox's first volunteer Rural Fire Dept., which provided fire protection for homes, farms and ranches within the rural community of Willcox. Harry was the Rural Dept. Fire Chief for 31 years. In 2003, Harry remarried, to his loving wife Beth and moved to Tucson, driving back and forth to Willcox to run T&O Enterprises and Willcox Rural Fire Dept. until he retired in 2016.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Virgil Woodrow and Corinne Beryle Owens, sisters Roberta May Owens, Sabina Levi and Coralene Rodriguez.
