Jack L. Hawes of Willcox died February 3, 2013 at the age of 77. He was born in Tucson on November 10, 1935 to A.L. "Fat" and Virginia (Heady) Hawes. Jack served in the US Navy during the Korean Conflict. He retired from Sulphur Springs Electric Co-op as a Warehouse Superintendent in Willcox. Jack was a member of the First Southern Baptist Church where he served as a Deacon and Sunday School Superintendent, was a Past Exalted Ruler for the Willcox Elks Lodge #2131, was a member of the Willcox Masonic Lodge #10 F. & A.M. , a member of the Willcox Holos Lions Club and a retired volunteer fireman for the Willcox Fire Department. On November 8, 1970 in St. Louis, Missouri he married Loretta June DeWeese who survives him. Preceding him in death was his parents.
