Jan Van Ingen of Willcox passed away in Tucson on Sunday evening, December 8, 2024, at the age of 77. He was born in the Netherlands on July 12, 1947, to Bertus Van Ingen and Leentje Bergwerff . Jan was my and my sister's grandpa, my mom's father. We live in the Netherlands, so me and my sister never had the chance to know him very well.

For me you were “my grandpa in America”, and I’ve always told my girlfriend that sooner than later I would love to come visit you in Mexico, or the States. I always saw my grandpa as a man with the American Dream. A man that left my grandma very gently because he simply wanted to know what adventures lie across the Atlantic. For me he was a man that fearlessly followed his dreams, that faced challenges no matter how big they were. Envisioning him as this person always motivated me to “live” myself. I always wanted to know him in person, as an adult, to meet him and show him the life I’ve built myself, but I never got the chance.

My grandpa was never there in person, but in a way he was still always there. He stayed in contact with our family: he texted and called with my mom, he even followed my exchange semester in Chile closely online. No matter the distance, Jan did everything he could to be a great father, and a perfect grandfather.

I’m gonna miss you, grandpa. I’ll always regret that I never got the chance to visit you as an adult, and I hope that you see me from above and that you can be proud of me. You’ll always inspire me, motivate me, and I know that you’ll always keep watching over me and supporting me in whatever I do. I’ll never forget you, and you’ll eternally live on, in my heart.

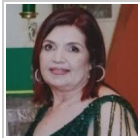
