Jeannette "Red" Charley, of Willcox died in Tucson on July 14, 2015 at the age of 83. She was born in Hibbing, Minnesota on June 29, 1932 to Matt Gantenbein and Hazel Lopp Gantenbein. On November 17, 1951 in Scales Mound, Illinois she married George Charley and they moved to Arizona in 1967. George and Red owned and operated the El Taco in Willcox. She knew no strangers. Survivors include her daughter Sherry (Bishop) Beeson of Eager, Arizona and her sons Tim Charley of Sierra Vista and David (Andrea) Charley of Show Low along with 4 grandchildren and 2 great grandchildren.
