Jerry Don Cranford passed away peacefully on July 29, 2025, just days shy of his 81st birthday. A devoted husband, loving father, proud grandfather, great-grandfather, veteran, and public servant, Jerry leaves behind a legacy of integrity, service, and unwavering love for his family.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 55 years, Carla Gene Quinn Cranford; his sons Michael Cranford, Randy Cranford (Torey), and Kellea Cranford (Kim); his grandchildren Jeran Cranford (Natasha), Mariel Cranford, Nicholas Cranford, Emaleah Davis (Ethan), and Misty Brown; and his great-grandson Maverick Davis. He was preceded in death by his parents, Thomas and Annie Cranford, and his son, Jerry Don “JD” Cranford, Jr.

Jerry was born on August 2, 1944, and graduated from Elfrida High School. Shortly after, he proudly enlisted in the United States Air Force, serving as an aircraft fuel specialist during the Vietnam War. He was part of the 37th Combat Support Group, stationed at Qui Nhon Army Airfield in the Republic of Vietnam from April 7, 1967, to February 6, 1968.

Following his military service, Jerry worked as a deputy with the Maricopa County Sheriff’s Office before settling in San Simon, Arizona, where he began work with Redding Pump and Well Service. It was there he met the love of his life, Carla.

Jerry spent over 30 years with the Arizona Department of Agriculture, Plant Services Division, where he became known for his dedication, work ethic, and knowledge. He retired from the State of Arizona with the respect and admiration of his colleagues and community.

Jerry's life is marked by service – service to his country, his state, his community, and most of all, his family. He was a quiet strength, a steady presence, and a source of wisdom and wit. He will be deeply missed and lovingly remembered.

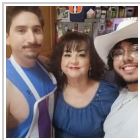

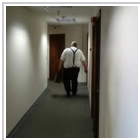
