June Elizabeth Vinall, of Willcox, passed away peacefully in the comfort of her home on June 15 at the age of 91. Her daughters Jennifer and Julie were by her side.

June was born in York, Maine on July 10, 1931 but grew up in Grosse Pointe, Michigan. As a young woman, June worked in advertising in Detroit where she met the man who would become her husband. June wed Jim Vinall on May 31, 1958 in Michigan, where they lived until 1963. They moved to Colorado Springs, Colorado where they raised their daughters. June was active with the Colorado Springs Assistance League and an involved 4-H leader.

In 1979, June and Jim moved to the Bonita area near Willcox, Arizona. June was the Executive Secretary to the Superintendent of Schools in Willcox for many years. She was an accomplished Master Gardener; she and a friend designed and planted the gardens at Keiler Park, the Willcox Police Department and the solarium at the Elsie S. Hogan Library. June was also an expert potter, and had the pleasure of teaching many community members how to throw beautiful pieces of art. June was a member of Lambda Chi Omega Sorority and a 50+ year member of P.E.O. International.

June is survived by her daughters Jennifer (David) Stover of Thornton, Colorado, and Julie (John) Hilton of Willcox, Arizona as well as her brother,

Robert Moffat of Los Altos, California. She also leaves behind nine grandchildren and thirteen great grandchildren who absolutely adored her. She is preceded in death by her loving husband, James Warren Vinall, her parents, George and Annie Moffat and her brother, George E. Moffat.

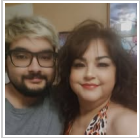
