



Lauralea Haby Bott

April 20, 1930 - December 31, 2023

Lauralea Haby Bott of Thatcher passed away December 31, 2023, at the Beehive Assisted Living where she received excellent care at the age of 93. She was born at the Haby Ranch House in Klondyke, Arizona on April 20, 1930, to Merrel Jacob Haby and Margarete Audrey (Duffy) Haby along with her twin sister Noralea. The twins were taught by their mother Margarete in the early grades at the 2-room Klondyke School, and later would accompany their mother and attend classes where she taught at several schools in Globe, Safford, and Duncan School Districts. They traveled back to the ranch in Klondyke regularly and during the summers. After graduation from High School at Duncan Lauralea and her sister started at Arizona State University where Lauralea would eventually change her major to Elementary Education to begin her life work with children. In 1949 she married Carl Bott who was working on the nearby Eureka Ranch. Lauralea started her teaching career at the Klondyke School teaching grades 1 thru 4 under a Conditional Teach Certificate. After receiving her bachelor's degree in Elementary Education in 1957. She started teaching first grade at Thatcher Elementary School in 1960 and would eventually retire from the Thatcher School District in 1987. She is survived by her sons David and Kelly along with nine grandchildren, seventeen great grandchildren and two great great grandchildren. Preceding her in death was her husband Carl in 1980, her sister Noralea in 2014 and her sons Paul and Lea. A memorial service will be held at 10:00 am on Saturday, March 30, 2024, at Westlawn Chapel with interment of her cremains in Sunset

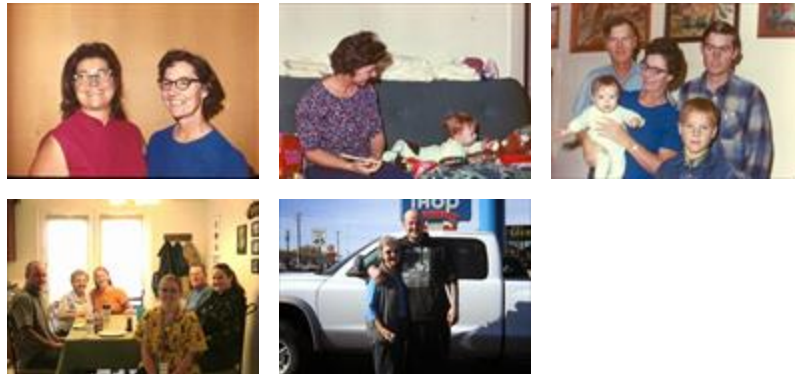

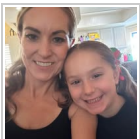
