Lois S. Tingle, of Willcox died October 28, 2015 at the age of 94. She was born in Kenna, New Mexico on March 3, 1921 to Harry W. Southard and Mamie Vinson Southard. Lois moved to Arizona in 1957 and was a member of the First Baptist Church of Willcox and retired in 1985 from the US Postal Service as a Postal Clerk. On July 31, 1943 in New Mexico she married Henard F. Tingle who preceded her in death in 1962. Survivors include her sons; Burton (Barbara) of Sahuarita, Arizona, Bill (Mary K) of Willcox, Dale (Barbara) of Corning, California and Bruce (Joyce) of Willcox.
