Louis E. Glover of Lakeside, Arizona and a former resident of Pearce/Sunsites, Arizona died in Tucson on July 11, 2016 at the age of 85. He was born in Belmont County, Ohio on November 20, 1930 to Edgar Glover and Grace Hinkle Glover. Louis was a carpenter, working for the Horizon Corporation in the early development of Sunsites as Construction Superintendent. He served in the US Army during the Korean War, was a member of VFW Post #9977, a former volunteer fireman for the Pearce/Sunsites Fire Department. On May 13, 1952 in Akron, Ohio he married his wife Claudette who worked for the United States Postal Service in Willcox, Cochise and retired from the Post Office in Lakeside. Louis is survived by his wife Claudette of Lakeside, a daughter Cindy Williams (Barry Ray) of Benson and grandsons Gregory Glover, Daniel Smith and Brian Smith along with 4 great grandchildren. His brother David Glover and his sister Dorothy West also survive him. Preceding him in death was his son Marty Glover.
