Lucie I. Mills a former resident of Willcox died on May 25, 2019 in Truth or Consequences, New Mexico at the age of 96. She was a graduate of Tucson High School, was a bookkeeper for Martin Drugs in Tucson for 15 years and worked at the University of Arizona.
