May 25, 1913 - October 17, 2013

Loving mother, grandmother and great grandmother Mae Collins died at home on October 17, 2013 at the age of 100 of natural causes. She was born in Merkel, Texas on May 25, 1913 to Seth and Celestine Everitt Hamilton. She moved to Willcox in 1952 from Texas and was an active member of the Willcox United Methodist Church, a longtime member of the United Methodist Women and the Northern Cochise Community Hospital Auxiliary. Mae was a wonderful seamstress, quilter and made many crafts. She probably made over 100 dolls and was very generous in giving away her works. Survivors include her son Toby (Kathy) Collins of Willcox, daughters Peggy (John) Ward of Glendale, Arizona, Nell Worden of Willcox and Polly (Bobby) Philpott of Flagstaff, Arizona and her daughter-in-law Jerry Collins of Phoenix, Arizona.
