Michael (Mike) Erps passed away December 25, 2021, at his home in Willcox, AZ at the age of 74. Mike was born June 30, 1947, in Sidney, Montana to parents Rex H and Margie D Erps. In 1954 the family ventured north to the territory of Alaska to pursue the good life in the last frontier. Mike spent many happy years exploring the forests, hunting and fishing. After graduating from high school in 1965, Mike enlisted in the army. He took advantage of being stationed in Germany, bought a Volkswagen and toured all the neighboring countries.
