Michael Alan Nelson, 83, Willcox, AZ, passed away on August 23, 2025, after a short illness. Michael was born March 5, 1942, in Arlington Heights, Illinois. The son of Mary Trask Nelson and Carl Nelson. He was a “ring man” in gymnastics during his adolescence. Michael graduated from Michigan State University in 1965 with a degree in English/teaching. Michael married Kay Pfeiffer on September 3, 1966 and had a loving marriage for almost 59 years. He and Kay moved to Willcox after he received a master's degree at the U of A in 1968 for counseling. Michael loved Willcox and called it his home for 57 years. He worked at Willcox Unified Schools for 38 years. During that time, he was seen as a: school counselor, a teacher, a cross-country coach and wrestling coach. He cherished his students and his community dearly. Michael loved running, biking, hiking, and swimming. But what he loved the most was his family.

Those left to remember Michael's memories are spouse, Kay Nelson; children, Paul Nelson and Kristin Nelson; grandchildren; Tyler Morganstern and Alexis Nelson. Michael will be joining his son, Jon Nelson, in the afterlife; most likely riding motorcycles.

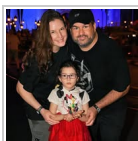

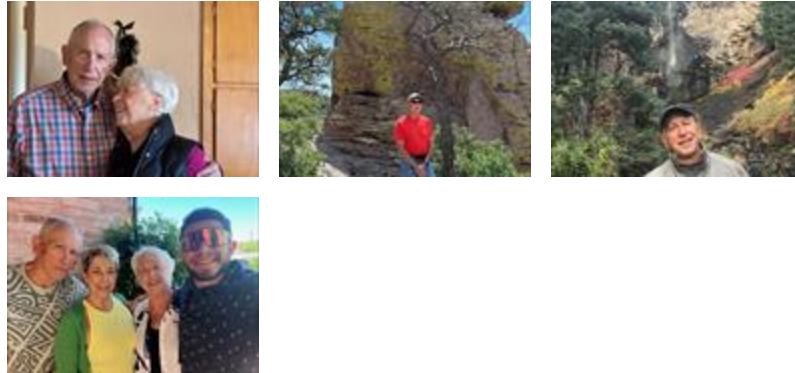
