



Morris "Hap" Mills III

October 9, 1978 - June 3, 2023

It is with great sorrow that we write this obituary to honor Hap Mills, formally Morris Eugene Mills

III, who died in his sleep on June 3, 2023. Hap was lovingly birthed at home in Benson, Arizona

on October 9, 1978, a rather large baby who would go on to become a gifted musician, an

incredible builder and problem-solver, a lover of cats, a proud father, and a gentle giant with a generous heart.

Hap took great joy and pride in his abilities as a musician. At the age of three, he told his mom

he wanted a drum and a copy of "Another One Bites the Dust," by Queen. His interest in drums

and music continued, and he became a section leader in his nationally recognized high school

band. Hap died with his high school drumline t-shirt still folded at the bottom of his dresser

drawer.

One could miss seeing Hap's genius, as he was a humble man. Yet he was a gifted writer, a

natural mathematician, and was quick to learn Spanish without the benefit of formal instruction.

Employers and family called upon him for all manner of projects—one day he might be fixing doors that no one else could figure out, designing and building counters and office spaces, fixing irrigation, or welding and the next he might close a shrewdly negotiated business deal.

Hap once saw an intricately built swing at a home show and went home and recreated it,

balancing and fitting joints of wood together perfectly without the benefit of nails, and lovingly

decorating it for his first daughter, who he affectionately called “Little.”

Hap’s heart was large, generous, and loving. He could not say no to rescuing a cat and could

be found coaxing them out of drain pipes, rescuing them from parking lots, and dreaming of a

time when he might be rich enough to start a “kitty city” teaming with rescued felines. If you

called late enough you might catch him laying down with his cats, crooning to them as if they were babies.

Hap loved his family dearly. He is survived by the greatest joys of his life, his children Emily,

Gage, and Savanna Mills; by his siblings, Amanda Blacow, Justin Mills, Janna Cook, and

Tiffany Dee; and by his mother Melanie Cook (Don Cook). He was preceded in death by his

father, Morris Eugene Mills Jr., who he remained devoted to all of his life.

In the end, Hap’s heart was perhaps too large and too gentle for this world.

Hap’s favorite

childhood stories included Ferdinand, a story about a bull who would rather sit and smell the

flowers in the arena than fight the matadors who taunted him. Like Ferdinand, Hap attracted people who looked to prove themselves tough on an oversized man who wanted peace, respect, and friendship. He struggled with the wounds of abuse that eventually broke his heart. Hap, we hope you are free to smell the flowers now and rest without the pain and the shame you carried for so long. We love you.
