



## Neil Alan Sprouse

May 6, 1958 - January 17, 2025

Neil Alan Sprouse (RET. US NAVY) passed away at home suddenly on Friday evening, January 17, 2025, at the age of 66. He was born in Portland, Oregon on May 6, 1958, to Waldo M. Sprouse and Ardith I. Spech. Neil retired from the United States Navy in 1997 after serving twenty years. He also retired from Boeing after twenty-three years in the Military Division. As a youth he was in the Boy Scouts of America until he was 18 years old, was a member of the VFW and was a member of two service motorcycle clubs in the Philippines and a Christian motorcycle club called Sabbath Keepers Motorcycle ministries in Lemoore, California. Neil was a member of the Seventh Day Adventist Church where he served as an Elder and Head Deacon at Armona, California and was currently head deacon at Willcox Seventh Day Adventist Church. Neil was known to be a jack of all trades, a great cook and baker. On November 11, 2011, in Three Rivers, California he married Nenita Mendoza Abdurahman who survives him. He is also survived by his daughters Christine (Matthew) Wilkinson and Laura (Trenton) Roberts of California and was preceded in death by their mother Lucena "Remy" M. Pagunsan. Also surviving is his grandchild Kyler Wilkinson and his stepdaughters Nadia Abdurahman, Sara Abdurahman and Susana Abdurahman. His sister Beth (Mark) Paul and his twin brother Paul (Teresa) Sprouse are also surviving along with nephews and cousins. Preceding him in death was his parents. A visitation will be held on Monday, February 10, 2025, from 5:00 to 6:00 pm at Westlawn Chapel. Military graveside services will be at noon on Tuesday, February 11, 2025, at

the Southern Arizona Veterans Memorial Cemetery in Sierra Vista. Please be in the staging area by 11:30 AM. A memorial service will be held at the Seventh Day Adventist Church in Willcox at 2:30 pm following the military graveside service.
