Pastor Vic Crews went to Heaven at 12:12 AM on Tuesday morning, January 20, 2021 in Tucson at the age of 74. He was born in Crescent City, Florida on February 19, 1946 to Victor R. Crews, Sr. and Willie Rebecca Walton Crews. Pastor Crews was the Pastor at Victory Baptist Church in Willcox from 1979 until 2000, when he moved to Tucson and was the founding Pastor of Coronado Baptist Church, and continue to Pastor the church until his passing. On January 26, 1966 in Checotah, Oklahoma he married his wife Cheryl who survives him. Also surviving are his children; Kelly Joe Crews and Channa (Clark) Vaught both of Tucson, Lynne (Lee) Wilson of Redding, California and Marcy (Ryan) Marsh of Berne, Indiana.
