Paul Thuerauf passed away peacefully at home on Saturday, August 15, 2020, two days before his 80th Birthday after a long illness. Paul was born in Mount Vernon, Iowa, August 17th, 1940, the 5th child of John & Helen Hudachek Thuerauf. Paul was a life long farmer, first in Iowa and then in the Kansas Settlement, Willcox, AZ.

On June 30, 1962, he married his wife of 58 years, Theresa Van De Voorde, in Brooklyn, Iowa, who survives him. Paul is also survived by his sons and families, Jeff of Phoenix, John (Adriana) of Plum City, WI., and Fr. Jason Thuerauf of Wheat Ridge, CO., Five Grandchildren, Michael (Chelsea), Sabrina, Mary, Mariana, and Daniella Thuerauf. 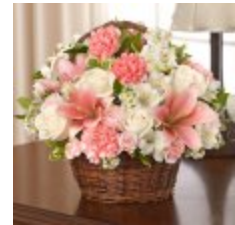

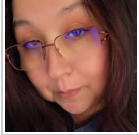
