



## Ramon Villado

August 9, 1930 - June 21, 2016

Ramon Villado of San Simon died in Gallup, New Mexico on June 21, 2016 at the age of 85. He was born near El Paso, Texas on August 9, 1930 to Castulo Villado and Tomasa Arrieta Villado. Ramon's father worked for the railroad and he was raised traveling the railroad tracks with his family. He served in the US Army during the Korea War, was a member of the VFW#2364 Pinetop-Lakeside, was a little league coach, loved to hunt and fish. Ramon enjoyed fishing at Roosevelt Lake and San Carlos Lake. He loved the mountains to the north of San Simon. From 1954 until 1989 he worked for the State of Arizona with the Arizona Department of Agriculture/ Horticulture and Arizona Department of Transportation at the Port of Entry in San Simon. On October 15, 1954 in Lordsburg, New Mexico he married Joanne Foley and she preceded him in death on June 30, 1995, he was also preceded in death by a son, daughter and brother. Survivors include his daughter Julia Ann Johnson of San Simon, granddaughter Patricia ( Brian) Thornbrugh of Pleasant View, Colorado and great grandchildren Madison, Braxton and Kyra Thornbrugh. His sisters Nicanora "Nica" Oliver of Fort Lauderdale, Florida and Anastasia "Tana" Hall of Tucson, and her sister-in-laws Celia Villado of San Simon, Julie (Carl) Chapple of Muskogee, Oklahoma and brother-in-law John (Gloria) Foley of Superior, Montana also survive him. Ramon is also survive by his , Great Aunt Carmen Baeza of El Paso, Texas, Great Uncle Kenneth Hudgins of Sierra Vista, and Great Aunt Dorothy Carlisle of Bisbee. 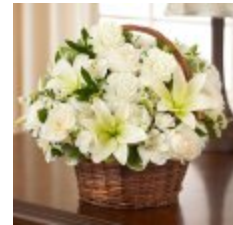

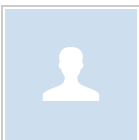
