



## Rudolph "Rudy" R. Ramirez

January 28, 1927 - April 17, 2013

Rudolph "Rudy" Ramirez a lifelong resident of Willcox died April 17, 2013 at the age of 86. He was born in Willcox on January 28, 1927 to Cruz Ramirez and Juanita Rodriguez Ramirez. Rudy served in the U.S. Navy during WW II, was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus, St. Vincent DePaul and part of the Cursillista Group thru the church. He was also a member of the Willcox Elks Lodge #2131, Past State Commander of the VFW, and was a long time member of the VETS Club and American Legion. Rudy also was a little league coach. He retired from SSVEC as a electrical surveyor on January 28, 1989 after 37 years. On April 14, 1950 he married Stella Garcia who survives him. Also surviving are his daughters Cynthia Fuller and Priscilla Miles both of Willcox and Rosemary Bonnett of Charlotte, North Carolina and his sons Rudy Joe Ramirez of Willcox and Randy Ramirez of Holbrook, Arizona. Rudy also has 16 grandchildren, 18 great grandchildren; his brother Robert (Pat) Ramirez and his sister Mary Lou Valenzuela surviving. Preceding him in death was a son Philip Ramirez, a son-in-law Ed Fuller, his parents, 7 brothers and 2 sisters. A Rosary will be offered 7:00 P.M. on Monday, April 29, 2013 at Westlawn Chapel, Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, April 30, 2013 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church.
