Lieutenant Colonel Shelby Stevens, US Army Retired, died April 12, 2015 at his home in Sunsites at the age of 91. He was born in Green Sulphur Springs, West Virginia on May 21, 1923 to Esra Stevens and Ruby Jewell Dunbar Stevens. Shelby retired from the United States Army on June 1, 1983 as a Lieutenant Colonel.
