



## Sid Garrett

March 21, 1930 - November 25, 2019

Sid Garrett passed away at his home in Pearce on November 25, 2019 at the age of 89. He was born in Red River County, Texas on March 21, 1930 to Leslie Theodore Garrett and Hattie (Grant) Garrett. Sid retired in 1993 as a pump operator for Phelps Dodge/ Morenci working on the Black River . He along with his wife Jolene were one of the founding members of the Valley Baptist Church in Sunsites, which now the Church at Sunsites.
