January 11, 1933 - March 21, 2017

Stark Edward Stephenson of Willcox died March 21, 2017 in Safford at the age of 84. He was born in Willcox on January 11, 1933 to Starkweather Stephenson and Mattie Mae Adcock Stephenson. Ed served in the United State Air Force during the Korean War. He retired from the United States Postal Service in 1992, serving as Postmaster in Elfrida, Willcox, Globe and Safford. Ed was a life member of the American Legion, a former member of the Rotary Club and Lions Club, he was a member of the Retired Postal Workers and was Past President of the Arizona Postmaster Chapter. He was a faithful member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, Willcox 2nd ward. On April 5, 1952 in Willcox he married Pauline Nelson who survives him. Also surviving are his children; Carol (Gene) Hawn of Winslow, Stephen (Betty) Stephenson of Fort Thomas, Darrell (Lori) Stephenson of Safford, Katharine (Tom) Curtis, Sandra (Toby) Skinner both of Gilbert and Karen (Dale) Howard of Brawley, California and his sister Treva Bradley of Elfrida.
