Tom Larimer of Willcox passed away December 20, 2023, in Tucson from multiple myeloma at the age of 81. Tom was born in Seattle, Washington on October 19, 1942. At the age of two Tom had polio and was in an iron lung and polio robbed him of the muscle in his left leg so he wore a brace. Tom had been a 30-year resident of Willcox and was a previous owner of Buckos Coffee Shop on railroad avenue. Tom loved people and interacted with several bands that came through town, and they played on the porch of the coffee shop, In the early days groups also came to his home where he had a swimming pool and volleyball net in the backyard. He was a long-time active member of the Willcox Elks Lodge #2131. He also had a shuttle service and would be especially busy during Rex Allen Days. At his request no services are planned.
