Troy was a professional bull rider being a member of the PRCA, was a welder, team roped and raised register Brahma Cattle. He broke colts and ranched. For many years he worked for the Kenneth Wheeler Family. Troy also was a judge for bull riding for several small rodeos. Survivors include his son Troy Johnston, Jr. of Willcox, his mother Sharon Bell, his father Randy Johnston and his sister Shari Johnston.
