



Walter "Buck" Mueller

August 9, 1909 - December 10, 2012

Walter " Buck" Mueller passed away, peacefully in his sleep, at the Circle B Adult Care Center in Willcox December 10, 2012 at the age of 103. Buck was born August 9, 1909 at Sheboygan, Wisconsin. He moved to Phoenix, Arizona in 1948 and operated a fleet of semi-trucks with partner Adolph Menke, known as Menke Transportation. He also managed a fleet of trucks for Watson Brothers Trucking. Buck served in the US Army as a Sergeant during WW II in the Philippines from May 1942 to November 1945. He was preceded in death by wife Muriel in 1998, and daughter Bette Graeb in 2010. He is survived by daughters Marelyn Curtis of Vancouver, Washington, Mervena Krening and son Walter " Bucky" both of Phoenix, Arizona. His choice was to be cremated and his ashes will be spread at the Cochise Stronghold near Pearce, Arizona where he formerly lived. A memorial service will be held 11:00 A.M., Saturday, January 19, 2013 at the VFW in Sunsites.
