May 4, 1924 - September 5, 2016

William "Bill" Winkler , long time resident of Rucker Canyon died September 5, 2016 at the age of 92. He was born in Ajo, Arizona on May 4, 1924 to George Andy Winkler and Kathryn Adams Winkler. Bill served in the United States Navy during WW II, owned and operated Rucker Canyon Ranch, in the 1950's he acted with Shelly Winters in several movies. He was a member of the Douglas Elks Lodge #955, Jerome M. Leonard VFW Post 426 in Douglas, Mount Moriah Lodge #19 F & AM in Douglas and was inducted into the Willcox Cowboy Hall of Fame. Bill was an avid musician playing the fiddle and guitar at many Rucker dances. On April 17, 1946 in Lordsburg, New Mexico he married Doris Seabaugh who preceded him in death on February 11, 2008. Survivors include his daughter Karen (Jim) Barnes of Tucson and his son Rusty (Glenda) Winkler of Rucker Canyon Ranch along with 3 grandchildren, 7 great grandchildren and 4 great great grandchildren. Memorial services will be 11:00 AM on Saturday, September 17, 2016 at the Douglas Elks Lodge with a flag presentation by the United States Navy. A barbeque luncheon will follow at the Elks after the memorial. Private burial was held at Rucker Cemetery next to his wife Doris.
